CLP Fee Regulation

The CLP Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008¹ on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures foresees that fees are set for requests under Article 24(1) and Article 37(3).

Article 24(1) of the CLP Regulation specifies that a manufacturer, importer or downstream user of a substance in a mixture may submit a request to the European Chemicals Agency, herein after called the 'Agency' to use an alternative chemical name and that such requests under Article 24(1) should be accompanied by a fee.

Article 37 of the CLP Regulation states that a manufacturer, importer or downstream user may submit a proposal for harmonisation of classification and labelling of substances to ECHA.

For both fees SME reductions are foreseen for each category of SME (medium, small and micro sized). In addition, for alternative chemical names the basic fee covers 5 mixtures and a supplementary fee is asked per 10 additional mixtures.
