CONSTRUCTION 2020 APPRENTICESHIPS

PLEDGE

The "Construction 2020 Apprenticeships Pledges" action is a multi-stakeholder initiative specifically created for the construction industry by the European Commission (DG for Internal Market, Industry, Entrepreneurship and SMEs) in the framework of the Commission's "Construction 2020" initiative and in close cooperation with the "European Alliance for Apprenticeship" (EAfA) coordinated by DG Employment, Social Affairs and Inclusion.

All pledges received will be published on the specific websites of both initiatives (links in footnotes 1 and 3).

THE AIM OF THE INITIATIVE:

Obtain pledges from the construction sector and relevant stakeholders leading to more and better apprenticeships. Pledges should therefore demonstrate concrete commitment and actions that will strengthen apprenticeships when it comes to one or more of the following aspects:

- 1. increasing supply
- 2. improving quality
- 3. improving the image
- 4. enhancing mobility

For instance, pledges could be linked to:

- a) Increasing the number of and quality of apprenticeship places in the construction sector.
- b) <u>Introducing elements of training in companies, construction training centres</u> and/ or schools that have not previously taken part in such schemes.
 - This includes actions aimed at changing mind-sets towards apprenticeship-type learning.
- c) Strengthening <u>specific training</u> in the construction sector, such as for <u>energy efficiency, resource efficiency or digital economy</u>.
- d) <u>Transferring</u> apprenticeship schemes which have proven their success in a country/region <u>to another</u> country/region where no such scheme is being used.
 - This includes actions aimed at changing mind-sets towards apprenticeship-type learning.
- e) <u>Improving existing apprenticeship models</u>, both general schemes practiced in a country/ region and specific schemes in individual companies, to increase the quality, efficiency and the visibility of such apprenticeship training models.

- The originator of the pledge is responsible for implementing any actions outlined in his pledge and commits to
 - o informing the Commission about the progress, once a year
 - o allowing the publication of these results on the same website as the corresponding pledge

DEFINITION OF "APPRENTICESHIP"

for the purposes of this action is the same as for EAfA

- "Apprenticeships are part of formal education and training programmes;
- Apprenticeships combine company-based training (periods of practical work experience at a
 workplace) with school-based education (periods of theoretical/ practical education followed in a
 school or training centre),
- Apprenticeships lead to nationally recognised qualification.

Most apprenticeships are based on a contract or a formal agreement between the employer and the apprentice, with the apprentice being paid for his/her work. Sometimes they are other contractual arrangements between the employer, the VET provider and the apprentice."

Internships and traineeships etc. are **not** in the scope of this action.
