- > Established in geographical area of CEPT
- > Committed to ETSI Statutes and Rules of Procedure

☐ Associate member


> Committed to ETSI's work, but not eligible for full membership (usually for geographical reasons)

☐ Observer

> Entitled to be full member, but not wishing to participate in FTSI's technical work

□ Counsellor

> Representative of European Commission or EFTA




















- □ Administrations, Administrative Bodies and National **Standards Organizations**

- Work Item must be supported by at least four ETSI members
- ☐ Separate Work Item for each deliverable
- □ Only one Technical Body is responsible for a Work Item
 - → although other TBs may be involved in drafting and approval
- ☐ Technical Body may request creation of a Specialist Task Force if the need is urgent













- **□** ETSI Technical Specifications (TSs)
- □ ETSI Technical Reports (TRs)
 - Approved by the TC or Project concerned
 - > Traditional or web-based voting



- **□** ETSI Standards (ESs)
- ☐ ETSI Guides (EGs)
 - > Approved by the full ETSI Membership
 - Web-based voting tool



- ☐ European Standards (ENs, telecommunications series)
 - Approved by National Delegations, through the National Standards Organizations (NSOs)
 - Web-based voting tool

PTCC: Methodology and techniques



- The PTCC have considerable expertise in the application of techniques such as:
 - UML (Universal Modelling Language)
 - MSC (Message Sequence Charts)
 - > SDL (Specification and Description Language)
 - > ASN.1 (Abstract Syntax Notation One)
 - TTCN (Testing and Test Control Notation)
- ☐ Techniques and Methodologies *shorten* the overall time needed for the technical development of ETSI products, reduce production costs and improve technical quality
- All these techniques are supported by powerful and sophisticated tools













- Coordinating big interoperability events with experts from **ETSI** and more
- Come&Test: developers come together to remove ambiguities
- People are active together in the same place for a week
- Saving time
- Could be complex and more difficult than conformance
- Not a laboratory, no certification













- ETSI Documentation Service on DVD; updates via web site










