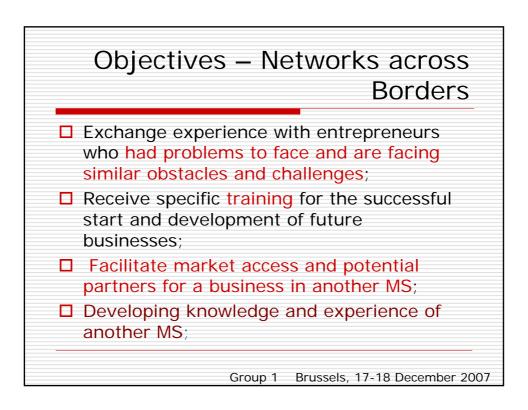

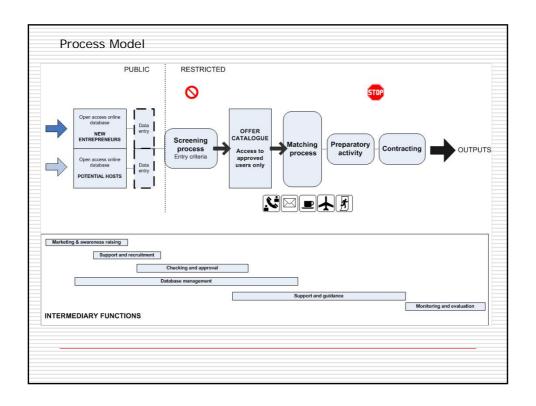

The "young" entrepreneur Plan for a viable business proposition; Entrepreneurial skills Want to capture those who are willing to "DO IT" Young in the *Heart *Minded *Motivated Group 1 Brussels, 17-18 December 2007
