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


# Trends: ever increasing number of arrivals and changed geopolitical context



### Over 700 million crossings/year

Air: 385 mio passengers (2014) 495 mio passengers (est. for 2020)



#### External borders

42 673 km of sea borders 7 721 km of land borders ~ 1800 border crossing points

### **Entry Exit System**

- Better monitoring of short stay rules
- Information on entry refusals





- Short-term migration becomes person centric
- Enabling border control automation and facilitation
- Supporting prevention, detection and investigation of serious crimes and terrorism
- Fact-based decision making when reviewing visa regime

- Improved border management
- Prevention of irregular migration
- Reinforced fight against crime and terrorism
- Complementing and safeguarding the visa liberalisation policy










Smart Borders: seamless travel from a user's perspective
