The beach of **Miliscola**, in **Bacoli**, was the Roman military academy headquarters. Lake Avernus was believed to be the entrance to the underworld, and is portrayed as such in the Aeneid of Virgil. Cumae was the first Greek colony on the mainland of Italy (Magna Graecia) and is perhaps most famous as the seat of the **Cumaean Sibyl**. **Baiae**, now lying underwater, was a fashionable coastal resort and was the site of summer villas of Julius Caesar, Nero, and Hadrian (who died there).
