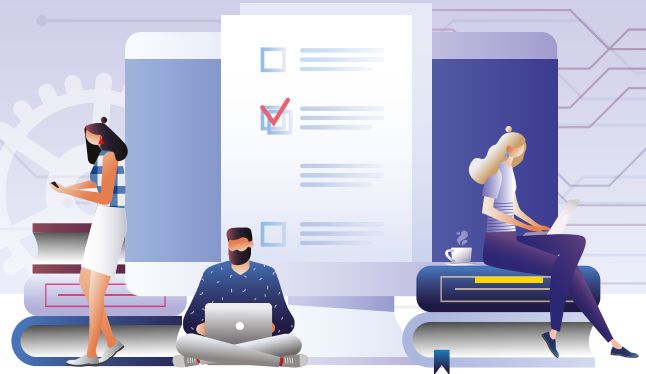

THE FIRST EU-WIDE DATASPACE AT THE SERVICE OF CITIZENS



2022

An increasing number of Europeans are completing many types of administrative procedures in other EU countries. For example, students are applying to universities abroad, citizens are moving to live and work in another Member State, and companies and the self-employed offer services and hire employees in countries across the EU. To facilitate citizens, businesses and entrepreneurs in completing administrative procedures across Europe, the Commission will set up a “Once Only Technical System”, creating the first EU-wide dataspace at the service of citizens. The system will help public administrations across Europe to share information and allow citizens to avoid submitting the same documentation multiple times, if another authority already holds that information in electronic format. Once available, the new system will operate within the Single Digital Gateway platform, a multifaceted European initiative that strives to create a cross-border digital infrastructure.
