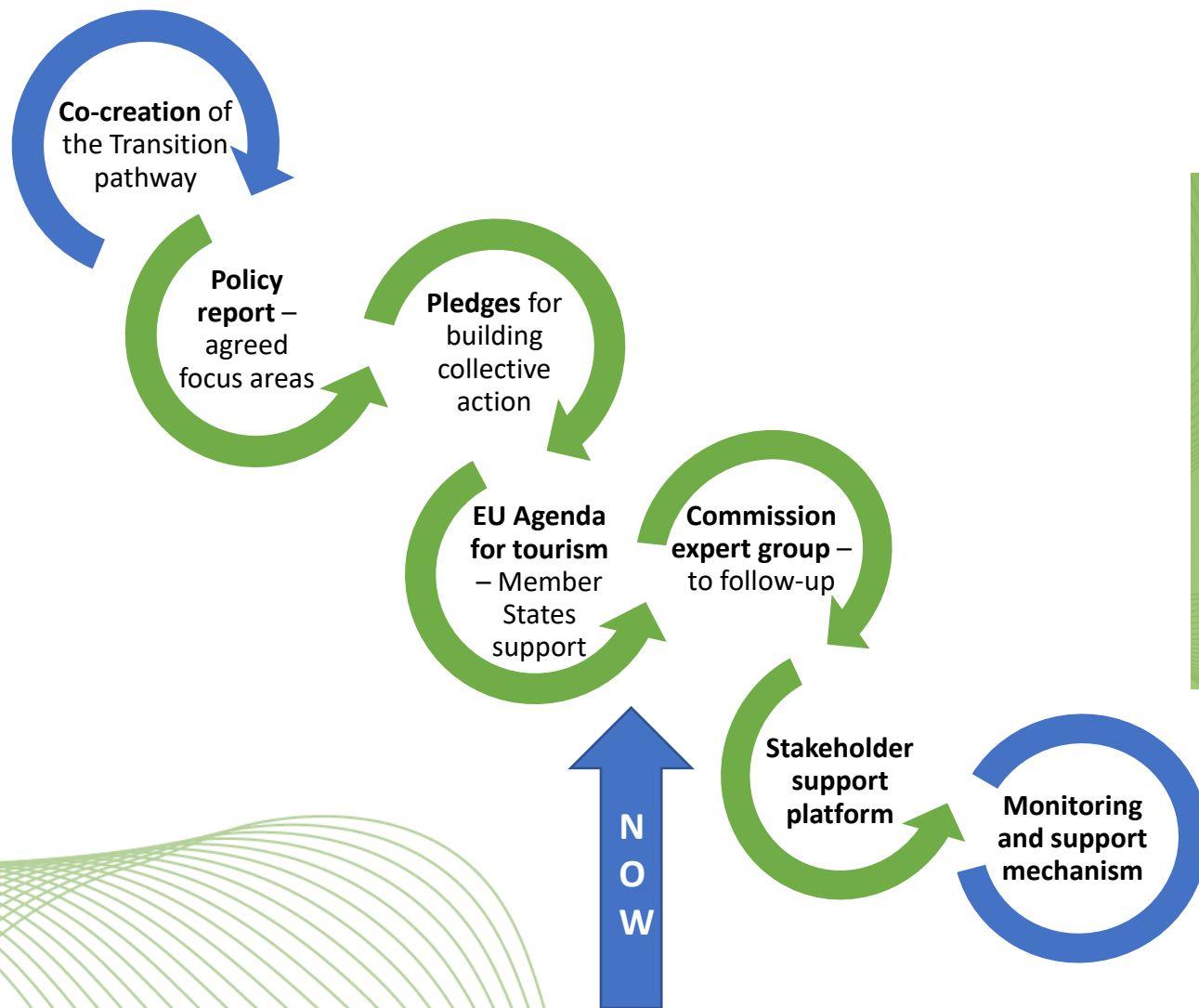

# Progress evaluation results should be

- **Timely** : based on recent data – describing situation after publishing the Transition pathway
- **Trustworthy** : based on data from official sources or objectively defined samples
- **Well-reasoned** : considering representativeness of sample, quality of data
- **Relevant** : describing useful elements for progress
- **Replicable** : to measure changes from year to year
- Based on **transparent** methodology and data : verifiable by independent researchers

→ Not just about presenting best practices, but quantitative KPIs complemented with qualitative data as illustrative examples

- Recommendations for revising actions and targets

# Monitoring of progress builds on several sources

- Pledges collection continues with cut-off dates twice a year at <https://ec.europa.eu/eusurvey/runner/Together4EUTourism>
  - continuously providing information on stakeholder engagement and outreach success
- Establishing a mechanism for submitters to inform about progress/completion of their pledge(s) through simple mechanism
  - to be integrated in the stakeholder online platform
- EU Tourism Dashboard with tourism ecosystem level indicators
- COM expert group and its working groups support reaching and gathering information on the transition progress among the broader stakeholder community
- Tourism Advisory Committee provides yearly information on the progress of EU Agenda of Tourism, also with relevance for the key areas for Transition pathway for Tourism
- Stakeholder support platform as continuously updated resource and activity hub provides information on participation and activities of tourism stakeholders across the EU
  - Annual progress update with key indicators each Autumn
  - Stock-taking studies as additional support

# Informal Commission Expert Group 'Together for EU Tourism – T4T'

Created to follow up, monitor and support actions in the Transition Pathway for Tourism & EU Agenda 2030

- Call for applications to select members published on [Register of Commission Expert Groups](#) on 19 January = **application deadline 16 February 2023**
- Open to **individuals** in a personal capacity (Type A), individuals representing a common interest (Type B) in the field of tourism, as well as **organisations** (Type C) and associations representing different sectors of the tourism industry, regions, local destinations, trade unions, social partners, organisations involved in research and innovation activities
- Member States were invited to nominate their representative to the Expert Group by same date.

# Objective and tasks

- **Group composition:** maximum 50 tourism ecosystem stakeholders & Member State representatives
- **Three sub-groups:** Green transition, Digital transition & Resilience (+ Inclusion + Skills)
  - **Maximum 15 members in each sub-group selected from the core expert group membership + MS representatives**

## Tasks:

- follow-up on TTP and European Agenda for Tourism 2030 actions
- exchange experience and good practice in support of TTP implementation
- monitoring outputs / contribution to the regular evaluations
- cooperation and coordination on Union legislation, programmes and initiatives in tourism
- help prepare policy initiatives resulting from TTP

# Application procedure

## Selection criteria (for Types A, B and C applicants):

- proven **competence and experience in areas relevant to tourism**, in particular in relation to the green transition, digital transition, resilience and inclusion, and skills (all applicants);
- absence of conflict of interest (type A applicants only);
- organisations that have **presented a pledge** to the TTP in the form of a commitment to support implementation of one or more actions among their members or within their organisation shall have priority in the selection process to become a member of the expert group (all applicants);
- proven capacity to represent effectively the position shared by stakeholders (Type B only);
- competence, experience and hierarchical level of the proposed representatives (Type C only);
- sufficient knowledge of English (all applicants).

Evaluation to take place in Feb/March in order to compose the group in the spring, first meeting to be called ahead of the European Tourism Day.

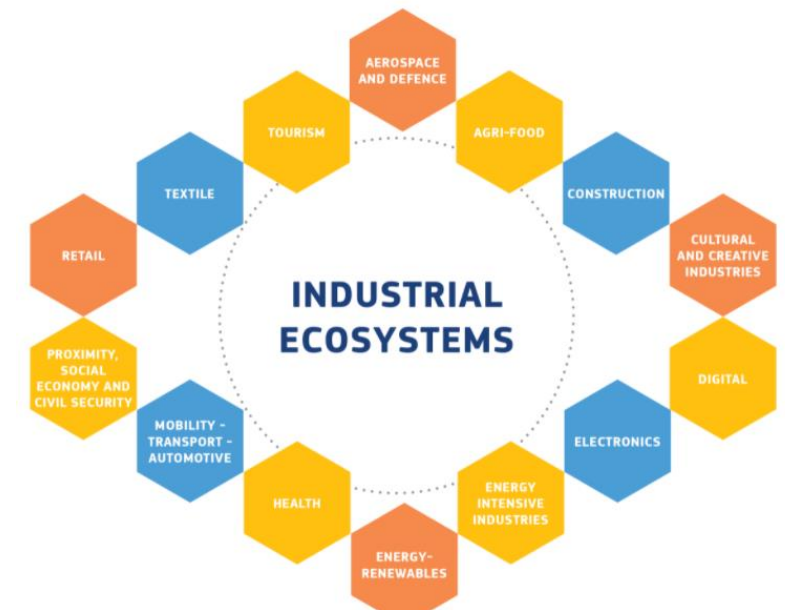

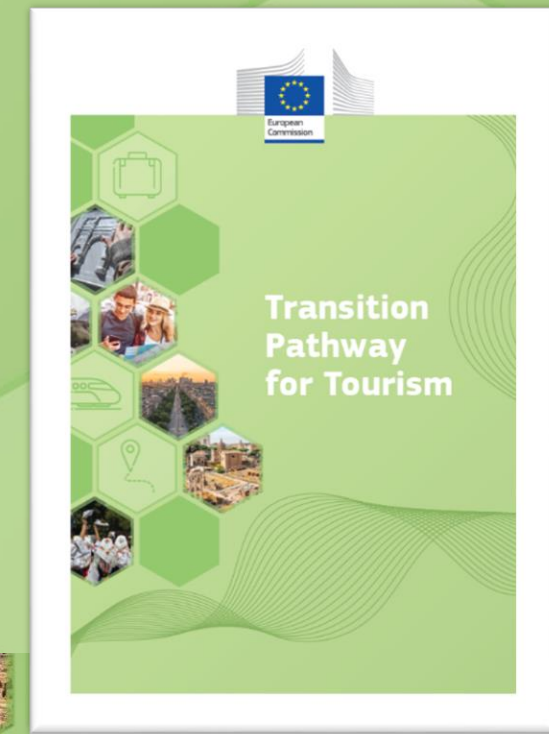
