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Abstract:			
<p>Under article 18 (5) of the Regulation 765/2008/EC setting up the requirements for accreditation and market surveillance for the marketing of products (the Regulation) Member States (MS) have the obligation to establish, implement, periodically update and communicate to the Commission and the other MS their National Market Surveillance Programme(s) (NMSPs).</p> <p>The programmes should ensure that the overall EU market surveillance framework, as established by Chapter III of the Regulation 765/2008 is respected. Moreover, they should allow the competent authorities of other MS and the Commission to understand how, what, when, where and in which areas market surveillance is carried out.</p> <p>This paper has the following objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• to report on the 2010 situation as regards the NMSPs (generalities, orientation and the way to go forward); and• to provide suggestions for further developments and improvements on the weak points such as: scope of the programmes, cooperation with customs, cooperation and coordination in general and presentation and accessibility of the information. <p>SOGS-MSG should examine the results of this first evaluation of the 2010 programmes alongside reports on what has actually been carried in 2010 in order to prepare for a more coordinate approach in 2012.</p>

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NOTE TO THE SOGS-MSG

Subject: 2010 NMSPs submitted under article 18(5) of the Regulation (EC) 765/2008 - Evaluation of the current implementation state in MS

• Generalities

Under article 18 (5) of the Regulation 765/2008/EC setting up the requirements for accreditation and market surveillance for the marketing of products (the Regulation) Member States (MS) have the obligation to establish, implement, periodically update and communicate to the Commission and the other MS their National Market Surveillance Programme(s) (NMSPs).

The programmes should ensure that the overall EU market surveillance framework, as established by Chapter III of the Regulation 765/2008 is respected. Moreover, they should allow the competent authorities of other MS and the Commission to understand how, what, when, where and in which areas market surveillance is carried out.

Further to the guidance on the establishment of the NMSPs of the Commission¹ and the common understanding between MS and the Commission, 2010 should be considered a pilot case and the methodology of the NMSPs should be re-examined in the light of experience and information gained.

• Objectives of the Working Paper

This Working Paper (WP) aims to inform on the current situation of the organisation of the NMSPs in 2010 and to identify and assess, via a comparative analysis (see Annex) the general trends followed by the MS in this area.

The purpose behind this evaluation is to determine a common approach for the future for the establishment of the market surveillance programmes (part I). Furthermore, and always in the same context, the WP aims to identify the missing points as well as the

parts suggested for further development or improvement in order to achieve a coherent and effective organisation for the establishment of national market surveillance programmes at EU level (part II).

1. State of play

1.1. Generalities

In 2010 all the MS, except one, submitted their programmes as provided under article 18(5) of the Regulation. Turkey and Iceland also submitted their programmes². Many MS have already sent their programmes for 2011. The vast majority of the programmes are annual. There are some MS (Ireland and Germany) that opted respectively for biannual and triennial programmes.

The general overview on the current stage of implementation as regards the obligation of the Regulation to establish NMSPs is positive. MS are manifestly making big efforts to comply as much as possible with their obligations under the different articles of the Regulation. The establishment of the NMSPs seems for the large majority to be done following the guidance provided in the Commission working papers. The trend shows also that MS are going more or less in the same direction in their methods of market surveillance framework implementation.

Nevertheless, not all the programmes allow effectively the other MS to understand how, what, when and where exactly surveillance is carried out.

1.2. As regards the orientation

The majority of the programmes reply to the scope of the Regulation and therefore cover mostly harmonised products, but some MS have extended the scope to GPSD. Under the GPSD scope very often come either harmonised consumer products such as lighters, oil lamps, laser indicators etc. or non harmonised products such as rollers, bicycles, children playing equipment not covered by the Toys Directive, etc. (Malta, Germany...).

The objective of the overall MS framework, as provided under article 16(3), is to ensure that any product covered by harmonised legislation placed and circulating on the EU market has to be safe. This general objective has to be taken into consideration and some MS (Germany for example) established a "catch all" programme in order to cover as much products as possible. Some programmes indicate not only the sectors in which the given MS is doing market surveillance, but also the concrete products concerned. However there are some programmes that do not indicate the sectors/ product area in which surveillance is performed although this information is essential to ensure the primary objective for transparency in this area.

The MS that opted for **general NMSPs** have mostly taken into account the elements of the Commission guidance related to that type of programme. They often include a link to the sector specific programmes. Often this is managed and achieved by setting up a coordination body of competent authorities. The information provided is quite exhaustive.

However, some general programmes do not contain either the minimum sector specific information required, or the covered product area, which is, as already mentioned, very important for the transparency and understanding of the given programme by the other MS.

Concerning **sector-oriented programmes**, often MS used the template provided by the Commission guidelines. Some MS have made slight changes such as adding or removing elements (e.g. Romania...).

Under the Commission guidelines, where MS opt for a sectoral NMSP it should include a part of general information. The latter is necessary for the understanding of the general context of the sector specific monitoring programmes. However there is a number of MS who have not done it.

1.3. The way to go forward

According to the guidelines and as agreed with SOGS-MSG, for the purposes of article 18(5) (6) NMSPs for publication should not contain details on the planned tests and on inspections for confidentiality reasons. However those available in CIRCA (restricted area) should be sufficiently detailed to allow authorities to see how exactly market surveillance under the given programme is (to be) performed. Therefore, there is a need to reach a common understanding on the **level of information to be appropriate in relation to the addressee**. It is obvious that the general NMSPs are more concerned and should be more detailed. That could be beneficial also for a better understanding of the programmes as well as better coordination and cooperation between MSA (Market Surveillance Authorities). To achieve the appropriate balance a clear distinction of what is to be public and what confidential could be a solution. The Irish programme goes in that direction. It contains a general narrative part for public information. It also has a confidential part, containing a timetable, premises and products to be sampled. The latter also includes a sectoral programme presented in the template table proposed by the Commission. A separation of confidential/ non confidential info is foreseen also by the Polish programme. Such type of organisation of the NMSPs is the best way possible to provide transparent programmes for market surveillance.

The NMSPs sometimes provide information concerning cooperation and coordination of market surveillance of programmes/activities. Sometimes it is not clear if and how exactly cooperation and coordination between MSA and between MSA and Custom authorities at national and EU level are performed. As regards cooperation with third countries there is a need to further improve participation of MS in particular to OECD, UNECE, etc. activities

Concerning the accessibility and transparency of NMSPs circulated for information between MS and the Commission, some MS (Finland, Lithuania...) have indicated only the websites where it can be found. That could create some difficulties for other MS and the Commission for lack of immediate accessibility that is worsened by the language knowledge.

Relevant other elements that could ensure improvements or further developments on the way to inform/to be informed on the NMSPs could be: the follow up procedures; reported matters; progress to date; quid for future actions. Few MS mention them (Austria, Ireland, Italy, Romania...).

2. Further developments and improvements

The evaluation of the NMSPs for 2010, as already mentioned, aims at identifying the gaps in the implementation of the market surveillance legislation and the trends followed by the MS in doing market surveillance in order to determine a common approach for the future. Although the 2010 experience is quite positive, an effective and coherent implementation of the overall EU framework for market surveillance under Regulation 765/2008 requires some major points to be considered for further improvement or development of the NMSPs.

The comparative analysis of the NMSPs for 2010 has identified the following points for future (re-)consideration: the scope of the programmes (1), the cooperation with customs (2), the cooperation and coordination between MSA (3) and the accessibility of information (4).

These elements, on which the analysis was mainly based, are summarised per MS and assembled in a comparative table attached. The comparative table outlines also the priority and type of control in the different sectors.

Furthermore it will be useful to always consider a follow up of the consequences of the programmes. In that respect there must be a clear indication of what is reported, what is the progress up to date. Those elements would allow identifying which could be the appropriate way to achieve effective market surveillance.

2.1. Scope

Taking into account the objectives of the Regulation and the relevant guidelines provided by the Commission for the establishment of the NMSPs, it is recommended that the programmes should indicate the product area in which the given MS does market surveillance. That would contribute to transparency of the programmes as well as to the determination of a common and/or coherent approach in: (a) the establishment of future NMSPs and (b) doing market surveillance by the MS in a given sector in a longer term perspective.

Furthermore, the achievement of the objectives of the Regulation requires that national infrastructures and programmes should ensure surveillance and effective measures for

products not expressly or already covered by the NMSP or by National laws transposing EU legislation and thus guarantee that only safe and conforming products are placed on the EU market.

2.2. Cooperation with customs

The obligations for MS under articles 27 to 29 of the Regulation imply involvement of the Custom authorities in the market surveillance activities for **all** products and in particular those imported (consumer, non consumer, professional, harmonised, non harmonised products). Article 27(2) provides for cooperation between MSA and authorities in charge of border controls. The organisation and distribution of responsibilities between national authorities is left to the jurisdiction of the MS. The appropriate way to ensure that effectively imported products are controlled at borders has still to be determined.

In the context of the globalised market and given the number of imported products on the EU market, cooperation with and between custom authorities is essential for an effective implementation of the Regulation 765/2008. Guidelines on cooperation with and involvement of the Custom authorities in market surveillance will be provided soon.

In this context, and given the fact that many programmes do not (sufficiently or at all) foresee/ inform on the cooperation with custom authorities or on the involvement of the latter authorities in market surveillance, this point should be further reconsidered in accordance with articles 27(5) and 24(2).

Clear determination as to how MS should organise cooperation and coordination could be beneficial for the transparency and better understanding by other MS. As the development of the cooperation with MSA and customs is very often designated as an initiative for future/ future priority follow up is recommended to be included.

2.3. Cooperation and coordination

The Regulation requires that MS ensure cooperation and coordination between MSA at both national and EU level. In addition, taking into account the number of the imported products from third countries, cooperation at international level is also necessary. This aspect is not really taken into consideration in the majority of NMSPs.

Many MS envisage further development of the cooperation and coordination.

Therefore, in respect with the requirements under Articles 24(1 and 2) and 18(1) of the Regulation, a clear determination as to how MS organise cooperation and coordination and how the relevant mechanisms are put in place is essential. The information provided on this point of the programmes should be re-examined to identify an adequate scale.

It is generally accepted that good cooperation and coordination is necessary to ensure a coherent and uniform implementation of the EU market surveillance framework. Those elements are essential for an effective, less time consuming and less expensive market surveillance (the latter being concerns addressed by several NMSPs).

For that purpose, depending on the state of organisation, it could also be useful to introduce competent coordinating authorities (see Luxembourg, Bulgaria ...) where they do not exist yet.

2.4. Presentation and accessibility

Concerning the presentation of the programmes, in the Commission's guidelines, it is suggested for the sector specific ones not preceded by a general part, to foresee it for the future. For general programmes that do not have links to sector specific monitoring it is suggested that they be ensured where missing. If all the programmes are presented in accordance with the guidelines they would be more transparent and coherence between them would be more easily achieved.

Follow up and progress to date could be included where missing. They could be an indicator of what is functioning well and what has to be improved.

Concerning the access to the NMSPs by the MS, the web site indication for a programme could be better replaced by a direct access or proper communication of the programme via CIRCA. An easy access for consultation of the programmes could be beneficial for the cooperation and coordination of the MSA.

3. Conclusion

There are already many signs of coherence and similarities between NMSPs, which should allow for discussion on priorities, common actions and comparability.

Nevertheless it remains room for **more coherence, transparency of information and comparability**. SOGS-MSG should examine the results of this first evaluation of the 2010 programmes alongside reports on what has actually been carried in 2010 in order to prepare for a more coordinate approach in 2012.

There is an intention of appointing a market surveillance coordination body that operates on the basis of the principle of consensus and fulfils the role of communication and coordination body for the MSA; Supporting them in their work to: Boost effectiveness; Provide assistance with meeting the accreditation and market surveillance requirements set out in Regulation No 765/2008; Exchange experiences and knowledge; Draw up recommendations; Coordinating the notification requirements laid down in Regulation (EC) No 765/2008: annual market surveillance plans; market surveillance authorities; contact addresses; four-yearly reviews; Consulting business and consumer representatives on their market surveillance priorities. The programme foresees follow up activities
