INFORMATION ON THE SECTORAL MARKET SURVEILLANCE PROGRAMMES OF MARKET SURVEILLANCE AUTHORITIES

2015

(for submission to the European Commission)

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Introduction

Regulation (EC) No 765/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council setting out the requirements for accreditation and market surveillance relating to the marketing of products and repealing Regulation (EEC) No 339/93 was adopted on 9 July 2008 to regulate market surveillance activities. The Regulation's requirements have been applied since 1 January 2010. One of its purposes is to establish a system of enhanced market surveillance as regards the goods covered by the harmonized laws of the European Union and the principle of traceability. The Regulation requires the Member States to perform and organise market surveillance activities in accordance with the principle of subsidiarity; specifically, Member States are responsible for setting up internal administrative structures and for the planning of market surveillance activities in order to achieve the goals of the Regulation.

The present document contains a summary of Latvian national sectoral market surveillance programmes for 2015, according to the information submitted by market surveillance authorities and in line with the requirements defined in Article 18(5) of Regulation (EC) No 765/2008 of 9 July 2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council setting out the requirements for accreditation and market surveillance relating to the marketing of products and repealing Regulation (EEC) No 339/93. The above-mentioned Article lays down that *Member States shall establish, implement and periodically update their market surveillance programmes. Member States shall draw up either a general market surveillance programme or sector specific programmes, covering the sectors in which they conduct market surveillance, communicate those programmes to the other Member States and the Commission and make them available to the public, by way of electronic communication and, where appropriate, by other means. In accordance with Article 18(5) of Regulation (EC) No 765/2008, the present document is to be submitted to the other Member States and the European Commission. In order to provide the public with information, an edited version of this document will be published on the website of the Ministry of the Economy¹.*

Information on the sectoral market surveillance programmes for 2015 was prepared in accordance with the methodology drawn up by the Commission for the drafting of national market surveillance programmes in accordance with Article 18(5) of Regulation (EC) No 765/2008.

In accordance with Article 15 of Regulation (EC) No 765/2008, the market surveillance requirements prescribed by this Regulation shall apply to products covered by European Union harmonisation legislation (any substance, mixture, preparation or good produced through a manufacturing process other than food, feed, living plants and animals, products of human origin and products of plants and animals relating directly to their future reproduction). The sectoral market surveillance programmes described in this document therefore include information on the abovementioned products.

Purpose of market surveillance

Latvia, as an EU Member State, must ensure that its market surveillance system complies with the requirements of the European single market and that only safe goods and services which comply

with certain key requirements are available on the Latvian market. Market surveillance forms part of the overall process of implementation of laws and regulations and serves as the main instrument for the surveillance of the safety of goods. Market surveillance is also a prerequisite for the normal functioning of both the internal market and the market economy. Market surveillance is performed in order to ensure equal protection of all persons in the territory of the EU, eliminating unfair competition and enhancing confidence in the market.

In accordance with Article 16(2) of Regulation (EC) No 765/2008, market surveillance shall ensure that products covered by Community harmonisation legislation which, when used in accordance with their intended purpose or under conditions which can be reasonably foreseen and when properly installed and maintained, are liable to compromise the health or safety of users, or which otherwise do not conform to applicable requirements defined in Community harmonisation legislation are withdrawn or their market availability is prohibited or restricted. The public, the Commission and the other Member States are informed accordingly.

The main purpose of market surveillance is thus to protect consumers against risks and threats to their life, health and economic interests through an effectively functioning market surveillance system and successful fulfilment of duties of the parties involved (economic operators, consumers and state authorities). Effective market surveillance is essential for both protecting consumer rights and ensuring equal and fair competition as it involves monitoring and checking the compliance of products and services available on the market and, if necessary, ensures that certain action is taken in the event of its being established that a product or service does not comply with the requirements.

The market surveillance system in Latvia

In Latvia, market surveillance is carried out by eight different authorities subordinated to five different ministries. Certain market surveillance functions are also performed by customs bodies controlling the flow of goods at the external border of the European Union. In 2000, a Market Surveillance Council was established to coordinate the work of these authorities. In accordance with the Statute of the Market Surveillance Council, the aim of this consultative body is to ensure the exchange of information and opinions between market supervision institutions. The main task of the Market Supervision Council is to promote a common approach to market surveillance, the cooperation of market surveillance authorities with regard to unsafe goods and services, and the division of competence among various market surveillance authorities in order to ensure the supervision of all goods and to prevent the duplication of functions. The Council convenes twice a year, and its function — the exchange of information among market surveillance authorities — is a crucial part of developing a common approach to market surveillance in order to establish an efficient market surveillance system which complies with the EU requirements.

In accordance with the Statute <u>of the Market Surveillance Council</u>, the Council shall submit market surveillance programmes and their summaries drawn up in accordance with the requirements of Article 18 of Regulation (EC) No 765/2008 to the Ministry of the Economy to be summarized by the latter and submitted to the European Commission and the other Member States.
