

Privacy policy statement

Your personal data are processed in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions and bodies and on the free movement of such data.

The controller of the processing operation is the Arnoldas Milukas, Head of Unit B2 at EASME.

The purpose of this processing operation is to facilitate the registration of interested persons at the Information-Day on Horizon 2020 Societal Challenge "Climate Action, Environment, Resource Efficiency and Raw Materials", as well as facilitate the participants organizing bilateral meetings with other participants.

The legal basis of the processing operation is Article 5(a) –processing necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest- and Article 5(d) –the data subject has unambiguously given his consent- of Regulation (EC) No 45/2001.

The following personal data are collected: name and title of the participants, organization, business contact details (e-mail address, phone numbers, Twitter account).

These data serve to identify the participant in order to register him/her for this event, give him/her access to the conference venue, and to include him/her in the participants list, which will be distributed electronically prior to the event and at the Information-Day meeting. In addition, they help contact participants if needed for the organisation and follow-up of the event, changes to the event, confirmation of the data submitted, updates on the event preparation etc.

The replies to the questions are **obligatory** as all the information requested is necessary to facilitate the registration process.

The recipients of your data will be EASME staff, agents of the security personnel, contractors and other participants of the Information-Day. The information in question will not be communicated to third parties, except where necessary for the purposes outlined above.

Your data will be retained for a maximum period of three months after the event. Data will be automatically removed at the end of this period.

You have the right to access your personal data and the right to correct any inaccurate or incomplete personal data.
