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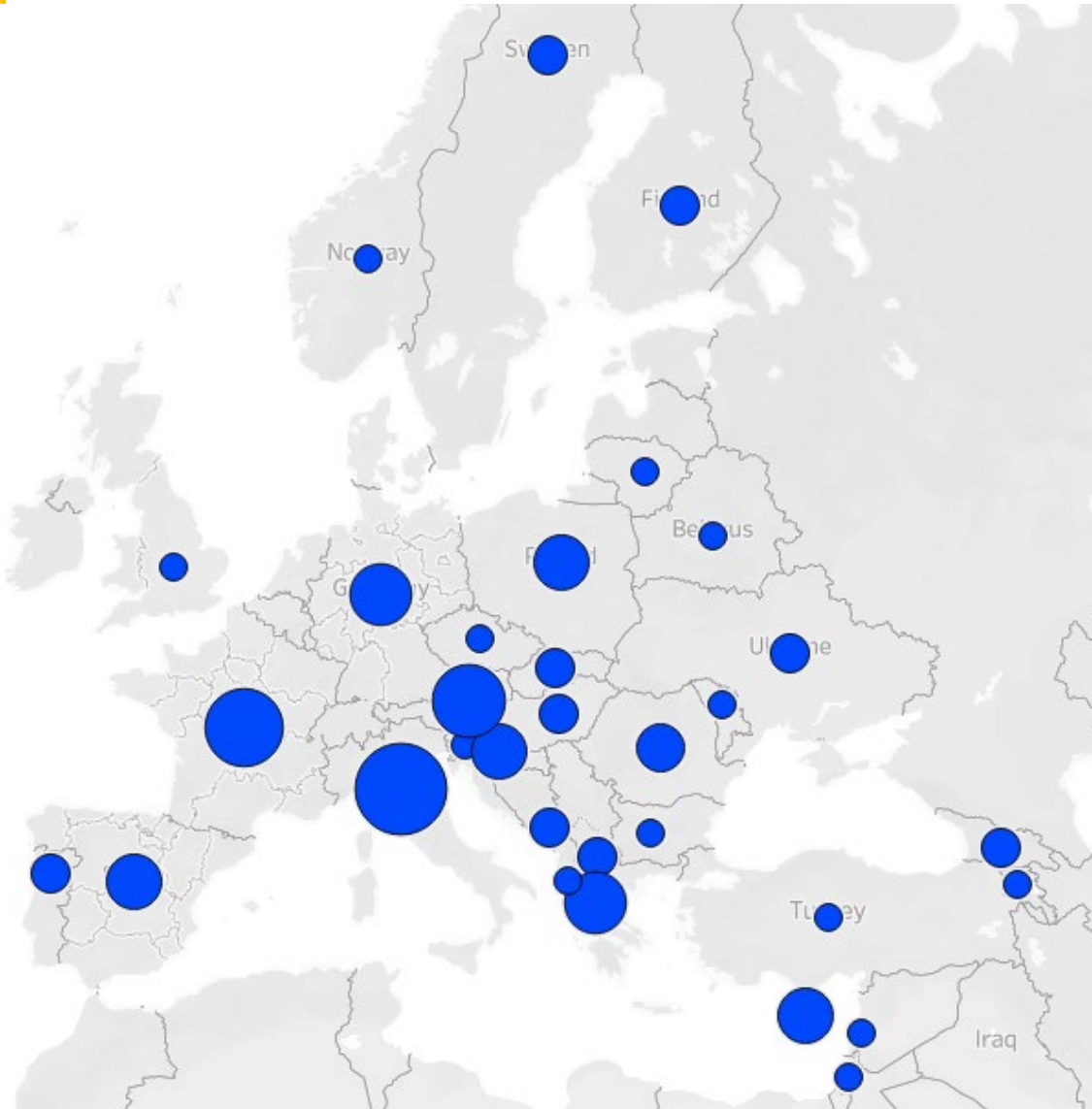

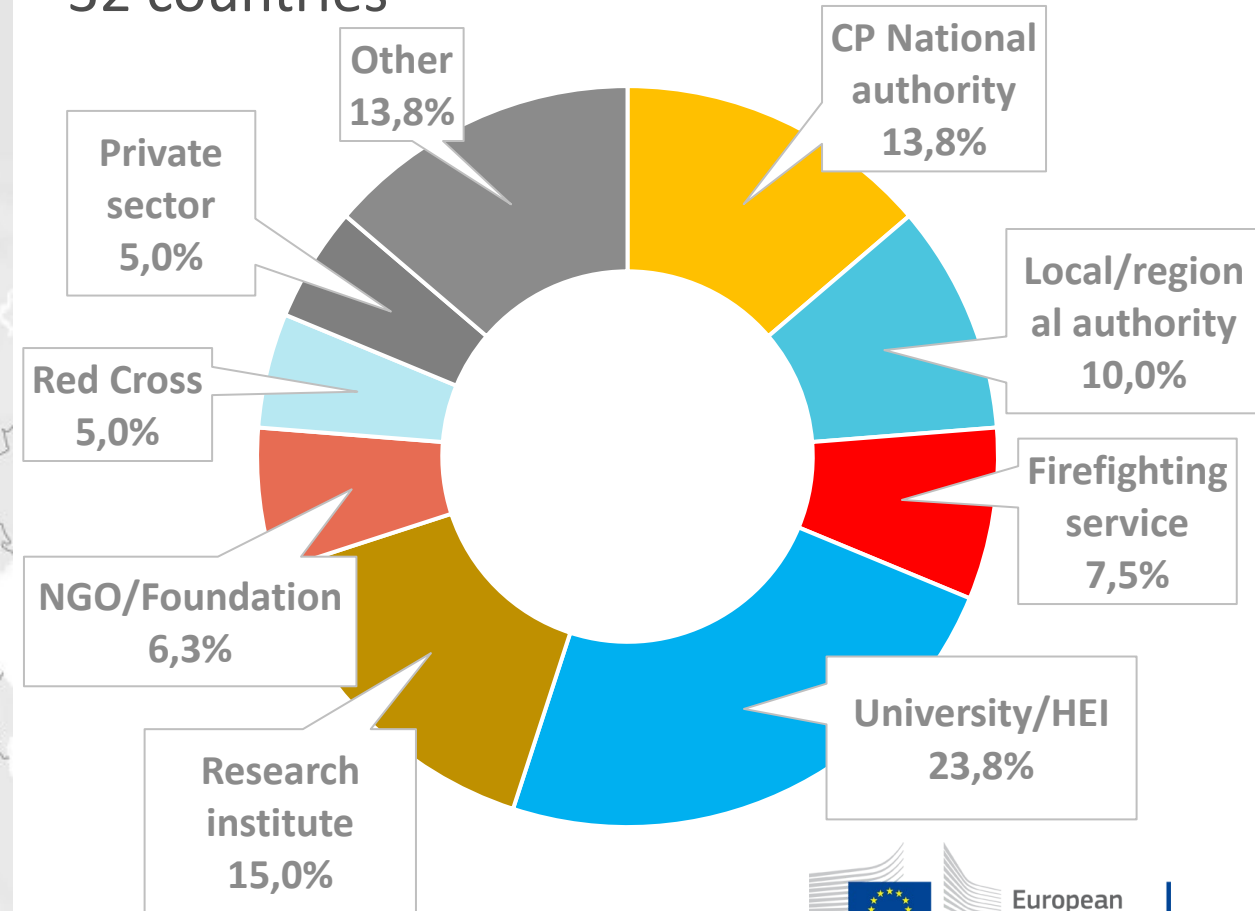

Focus of UCPCM-2022-KN call

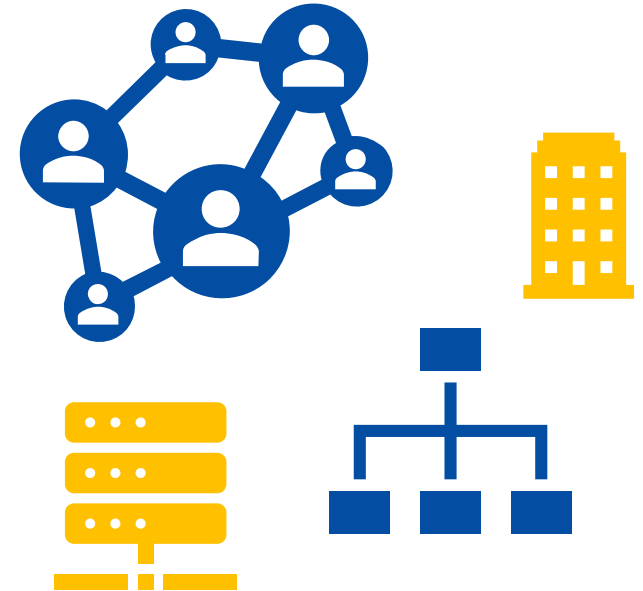
- Development of thematic communities/centres of expertise approach
- Capacity building and science – in support of KN pillars
- Additional funding for activities related to health emergencies



Objective 1

Design, develop and implement multi-disciplinary, risk-based thematic communities/centres of expertise for civil protection and disaster management stakeholders

» Structures that allow stakeholders to own and lead their communities



Objective 2

Design, develop and implement capacity-development and applied science activities that contribute to building and sharing of knowledge, expertise and skills in civil protection and disaster management



Applied knowledge and tangible outputs



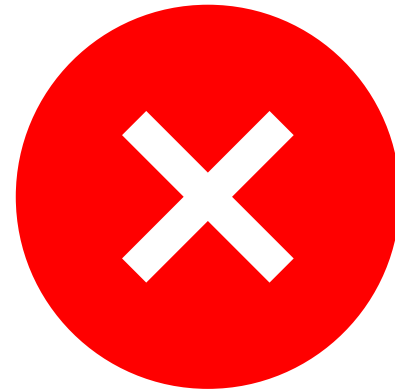
Particularities

- Proposals must address both objectives in call
- Two funding sources in one call:
 - General budget: EUR 1,500,000
 - Next Generation EU budget: EUR 2,500,000



Non eligible activities

- Online platforms
- Full-scale exercises (FSX)
- Border risk assessments

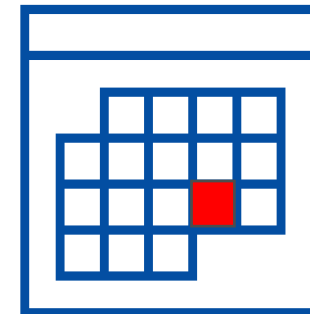


Scoping, comparative, feasibility), research and studies, qualitative analyses, scenario-building, awareness-raising and communication, modular, training of Trainers, ad hoc) trainings, exposure and exchange visits and other mobility activities, coaching and mentorship, development and testing of new technologies and IT tools, analysis and reporting, simulations, workshops, seminars, communication activities, exercises to test methods/solutions, meetings, networking events, studies, surveys, research, retreats, workshops, seminars, development and testing of new technologies and IT tools...etc.

- Three applicants from 3 different MS/PS
- Applicants from eligible third countries
- One consortium coordinator
- CP authority as consortium coordinator (other public entity with CP support)
