

## **PSI training and certification trajectory in Sweden**

Public service interpreting in Sweden is offered at [folk high schools](#) (a type of post-secondary education popular in Northern Europe) and at Stockholm university.

Folk high school [courses](#) are typically four months (often given on half- or quarter time over a year or two). They cover theory and terminology on topics common in public service interpreting: social services, employment market, medicine and law. They are monitored by the Swedish National Agency for Higher Vocational Education.

There is also a [course at BA-level at Stockholm University](#). The course is two semesters long and also covers terminology on theory on the common topics (see above). The course also has a focus on practical exercises and theory of interpreting.

Interpreters with a certificate from a state-monitored education can register as trained interpreters at the [Swedish Agency for Authorizations of Interpreters](#).
