**Description of the solution**

Lincus is a healthcare app and web software system that improves the health and wellbeing of users through integrated evaluation, monitoring, feedback, education, communication and integration (with third party devices and systems) services.

It promotes self-care and improves engagement between patients and service providers through easy to use care management and reporting tools including alert functions.

Lincus provides data aggregation, analytics, visualisation and report generation in relation to the impact of services and interventions on groups and individuals.



**Innovative features and added-value compared to the actual situation**

Current solutions that improve self-care focus on single conditions. Lincus provides a self-care platform for people with multiple conditions with co-developed solutions that address shared care. Lincus provides support for people with Long Term Conditions, and also for their formal and informal carers and the decision makers and administrators in the organisations that support them.

Lincus provides attractive and accessible picture based and customisable user interfaces to capture patient reported outcome measures.

It integrates social, emotional, mental and physical metrics from self-report, data from >200 different devices, apps and services along with health and social care data, providing a comprehensive high resolution dynamic health profile.

Lincus uses this health profile to match users with trusted and personalised content to improve health literacy.

**Economic, health, social & environmental benefits of the solution when in use in care settings**

Lincus has been consistently shown to improve engagement and positively impact behaviour changes of individuals and also their carers.
