The organisers will assess all applications received, and will confirm your attendance, approximately by the week of 29 June. Please do not make any reservations until you have received a confirmation email.

For the selected participants, travel and accommodation (hotel) costs may be covered by the European Commission. However, please note, that travel and accommodation is not automatically provided. If you/your organisation is unable to cover these costs, please indicate it in the application form.
