Breakout 1 – Interactive Workshop.

Strengthening AKIS connections to meet the digitisation challenges

- **Session Description:** Participants will be divided according to colour on their badge exploring functioning/dynamic of AKIS. In each break-out, participants work on round tables with 6-7 people on each. Groups forming/behaving as small AKIS / proto-AKIS
- **Mission/task to accomplish:**
 - **STEP 1.** Each group makes a 'draw' of AKIS (based on given template -figure of AKIS provided just as a reference)
 - **STEP 2.** On the AKIS draw, identify areas/connections/flows where digital technologies can generate improvements/added value.
- **Objective of the session**
 - Identify areas/connections/flows where digital technologies can generate improvements/added value in the functioning of AKIS
 - The Role playing scenario aims to expose participants to different viewpoints or ways of thinking about AKIS
 - This activity will set the ground for breakout session 2

Breakout 1: Exploring functioning/dynamic of AKIS

Group activity (6/7 participants)

Mission

STEP 1. Each group makes a 'draw' of AKIS (based on given template -figure of AKIS provided just as a reference).

STEP 2. On the AKIS draw, identify areas/connections/flows where digital technologies can generate improvements/added value.



Breakout 2 – Interactive Workshop
