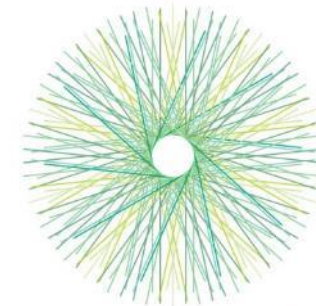


Birch sap tapping in Finland
