

## Challenge





The main topic of the network is **the control of diseases** that jeopardise the future grape production: Grapevine trunk diseases and Flavescence Dorée

Actually spreading  $\rightarrow$  need to share **knowledge** and **control methods** from people actually managing the diseases to people without the diseases

Heterogenous research effort through europe → share research results (COST FA 1303)

**Improve exchanges** between science and practice Innovation from the field need to be share with research and share among growers

→ Bring solutions (existing or new) to control these diseases

- 7 European countries
- 10 wine regions
- 11 partners
- Duration: 30 months










#### A massive communication about the existence of the tools...
