- **ERASMUS +**
 - Students going abroad
 - Teachers going abroad (to teach/to get trained)
 - International master courses
 - Young entrepreneurs getting mentorship from experienced ones (4% of farmers)
- **Horizon 2020: Marie-Slodowska Curie Actions:**
 - Innovative training networks – training bringing together scientists and businesses
 - R&I staff exchange
- **EIT Knowledge and innovation communities:**
 - Bring businesses, researchers and education together
 - → train new entrepreneurs

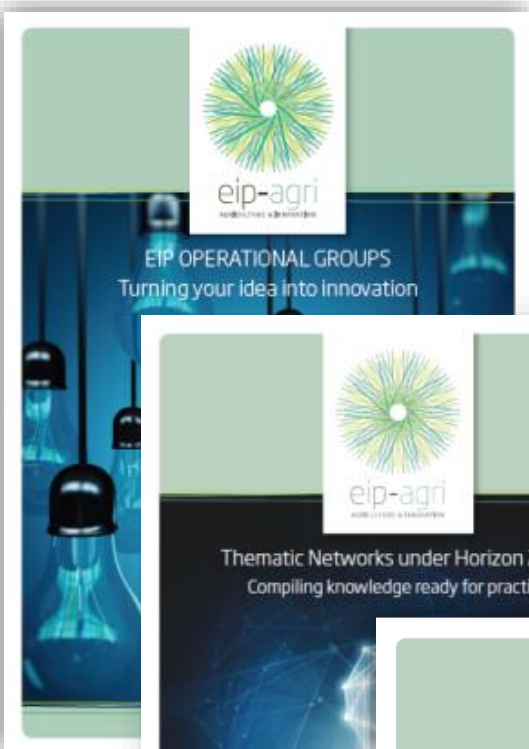

- For Who? farmers, foresters, food and rural SMEs
- *What?*
 - **Knowledge transfer and information actions (M01):**
 - Vocational training and skills acquisition
 - Demonstration and information
 - Farm and forest management exchange + farm/forests visits
 - **Advisory services, farm management and farm relief services (M02):**
 - Tailored advice on specific issues
 - Setting-up of services
 - Training of advisors
- *How?*
 - **Advice providers are supported for the service rendered**
