Innovation Support Service Providers appear to be creating pathways for key actors to connect.


This connective role deserves more **recognition** in current structures for policy, funding and management.


Peer to peer learning in cross visits has a significant impact on the way participants think.

Innovation Processes are messy Don't treat them as projects!









The innovation spiral




