Selection criteria EIP operational groups 2017



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Selection criteria:

1. Composition of the operational group (max 8 points):

- Good mix and relevance partners clear
- Active commitment
- Necessary expertise available
- commitment farmer

2. Objectives of the operational group (max 8 points):

- Clarity and relevance of the objectives
- Contribution to the challenges in the agriculture and horticulture sector
- Relevance in the context of the EIP objectives / crisis measures

3. Quality of work plan and proposed actions (max 4 points)

- Is the work plan coherent and of good quality, allowing to achieve the objectives?
- Do the actions fit with the objectives?
- Are the actions feasible, relevant and realistic within the proposed project duration?
- Is the estimation of costs clear and realistic?
- Does the work plan follow a bottom-up approach? => partners & commitment

4. Method of dissemination of results (max 4 points):

- Are the results sufficiently communicated or distributed to the target group?
- Are different channels used (e.g. presentations, working groups, lectures, press articles, experimental fields, etc.)?
- Is the dissemination going beyond the regular activities of the partners?
- Is the frequency sufficient and are the dissemination actions sufficiently concrete?

5. Complementarity with existing initiatives (max 4 points):

- Use of knowledge from current and past projects
- The group works in a complementary way with existing initiatives
- Sufficient knowledge is present about the theme

Eligibility conditions:

- application form received in time
- application form signed
- budget in accordance with call
- duration of the project is in accordance with call
