
Schedule

FOR PARTICIPANTS WHO HAVE TRAVEL AND HOTEL ORGANISED BY THE EIP-AGRI SERVICE POINT, PLEASE FIND SOME INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR TRIP.

The travel agency 'Omnia Travel' will send you a voucher for the hotel which you will need to print and present at your hotel upon arrival. Omnia Travel will also provide you a proposal on your flight, train or bus and detailed information about the specific shuttles which are organised from the airport to the hotel. Participants will stay in two hotels. Participants who stay in the Hilton Hotel can walk from the airport to the hotel. Participants who stay in the Novotel will travel by shuttle. These shuttles will also take you back to the airport at the end of the event.

Transport to and during the workshop

Day 1- 21st September 2016:

08.00 AM Pick up of participants at both hotels and trip to the International Culture Centre (Międzynarodowe Centrum Kultury), Market Square 25. Buses are not allowed in the historic centre. Participants will be dropped off near the centre and walk the last 100-200 m guided by the organisers.

Three buses will pick up participants at **Hilton Garden Inn Krakow Airport hotel** (Kapitana Mieczyslawa Medweckiego 3, Balice, 32-083, Poland)

Two buses will pick up participants at **Novotel City Krakow West** (Al. Armii Krajowej 11 30-150CRACOW -POLAND)

2.00PM Buses will wait for participants in front of the International conference centre and will take them to 5 different field trips locations, 1 bus per field trip destination.

Field trip destinations are:

- 4. Setting up & funding short chain supply, Higher School of Banking Address: 14 Kijowska Street, 30-079 Kraków
- Local food in private sector procurement, Bonarka City Centr area Address: Kamieńskiego 11, 30-644 Kraków. Exact location to be confirmed - Elekrolux, State Street, Alexander Mann

After the field visits, all the buses will travel to the **Rohatyna Centre** in Liszki (Karczma Rohatyna, Cholerzyn 361, 32 – 060 Liszki) for local products trade fair and networking dinner.

10.30PM Buses will wait for participants at the networking dinner venue (Karczma Rohatyna, Cholerzyn 361, 32 – 060 Liszki)and will bring them back to their respective hotels after the dinner.

Three buses will head to the **Hilton Garden Inn Krakow Airport hotel** (Kapitana Mieczyslawa Medweckiego 3, Balice, 32-083, Poland)

Two buses will head to **Novotel City Krakow West** (Al. Armii Krajowej 11 30-150 CRACOW - POLAND)

Day 2-22nd September 2016:

08.30 AM Pick up of participants at both hotels and trip International Culture Centre (Międzynarodowe Centrum Kultury), Market Square 25, Kraków

Three buses will pick participants at **Hilton Garden Inn Krakow Airport hotel** (Kapitana Mieczyslawa Medweckiego 3, Balice, 32-083, Poland)

Two buses will pick participants at **Novotel City Krakow West** (Al. Armii Krajowej 11 30-150CRACOW - POLAND)

To make it clear for participants, signs will be put on the buses to recognize easily those travelling to/from the Hilton Hotel and those travelling to/from the Novotel.

Signs will also be put to recognize easily which fieldtrip the buses will be heading to.

02.00 PM A bus will transfer participants back to the hotels (before leaving to the airport) for people that wish so. People who have a later flight and want to stay in the Centre may skip this and travel back by taxi or metro to their hotel or airport at their own expenses. For people that leave on the 23^{rd} of September from the Novotel, shuttles will be organised.

Public transport

The airport advises the following about transfer from the airport to the centre:

'We encourage all passengers to make use of the possibility of traveling to/from our airport by train. The new Kraków Airport train station is located near the passenger terminal, at the rear of the multi-storey car park. The connection is operated by Koleje Małopolskie (regional railways company operating in Małopolska Region). Travelling by train is the fastest way to get to-/from the airport (ex. the journey to the city center takes about 17 minutes). Trains are equipped with air conditioning, power outlets, Wi-Fi and ticket machines. All trains also have spaces for disabled passengers and persons with reduced mobility (PRM).
