

The "Circular Economy package"



- A Communication and Action Plan covering the whole value chain (product design, production, consumption, waste management) as well as specific sectorial actions (e.g. food waste, biomass and biobased products)
- A revised legislative proposal on **waste** recycling targets
- A review of the **fertilisers** regulation
