


Forest industry's biggest investment in Finland, ever

- EUR 1.2 billion investment (investment decision made in April, 2015)
- · A 'bioproduct mill'
- Annual pulp production 1.3 million tonnes (currently 0.5)
- Use of wood 6.5 million m³ annually (currently 2.4)
- About 2,500 direct jobs in the whole value chain in Finland (currently 1,000)
- Main markets for the pulp: Europe and Asia
 - Sales will increase especially in China
- Further development of the business ecosystem linked to the Äänekoski site
- The mill will be ramped up during the third quarter of 2017




The use of domestic wood can be increased sustainably

Taking the business ecosystem to the next level




- The business ecosystem is already there

- An ecosystem creates competitiveness on global scale







The share of bioproducts will increase

Bioproducts' share of sales, %












Bioproduct mill in operation in Q3/2017
