Host Country	Expected	Topic
SWEDEN 1	22-23 April	Local mobilisation of all relevant stakeholders and public authorities to tackle poverty, social exclusion and ethnic segregation in the metropolitan regions.
UK 2	5-6 May	Rough-sleepers eradication strategy.
AUSTRIA 3	7-8 June	Assistance to young people with special needs during transition from school to work.
NETHERLANDS 4.	15-16 June	Promoting the integration into the labour market of benefits claimants: people with no or minimal qualifications, drug addicts, persons with psychological and social problems, disabled persons.
FINLAND 5	23-24 September	Mobilisation of all relevant stakeholders and public authorities: to generate welfare services and support through collaboration concentrating on preventing threats and risks and actively overhauling services concepts and welfare services structures
FRANCE 6	8-9 November	Promoting the integration of new migrants legally settling for a long period, pushing forward an integration policy, fighting against any form of intolerance, developing guidance and support for newcomers, integration "contracts" and services benefit (language courses, pre-professional orientation, link with employment public service, information. . .)
IRELAND 7	18-19 November	Preventing and tackling the over-indebtedness of low income families.
GERMANY 8	6-7 December	Reconciliation of work and parental responsibilities in order to promote the participation of women in the work place (experimentation and cost-benefit evaluation of new measures in partnership with different sized enterprises)
ITALY 9	January 2005	Preventing the risks of exclusion of families with difficulties in order to avoid a separation between parents and children: through measurements/ advice to resolve difficulties at school, hygiene, childcare for young children (babies), cultural/play opportunities...
