RDP priorities and focus areas 2014-2020

PRIORITY 1: "Fostering knowledge transfer and innovation in agriculture, forestry and rural areas"

- Focus area 1A: Fostering innovation, cooperation and the development of the knowledge base in rural areas
- Focus area 1B: Strengthening the links between agriculture, food production and forestry and research and innovation, including for the purpose of improved environmental management and performance
- Focus area 1C: Fostering lifelong learning and vocational training in the agriculture and forestry sectors

PRIORITY 2: "Enhancing farm viability and competitiveness of all types of agriculture in all regions and promoting innovative farm technologies and sustainable management of forest"

- Focus area 2A: Improving the economic performance of all farms and facilitating farm restructuring and modernizations, notably with a view to increase market participation and orientation as well as agricultural diversification
- Focus area 2B: Facilitating entry of adequately skilled farmers into the agricultural sector and in particular generational renewal

PRIORITY 3: "Promoting food chain organisation, including processing and marketing of agricultural products, animal welfare and risk management in agriculture"

- Focus area 3A: Improving competitiveness of primary producers by better integrating them into the agri-food chain through quality schemes, adding value to agricultural products, promoting in local markets and short supply circuits, producer groups and inter-branch organizations
- Focus area 3B: Supporting farm risk prevention and management

PRIORITY 4: "Restoring, preserving and enhancing ecosystems related to agriculture and forestry"

- Focus area 4A: Restoring and preserving and enhancing biodiversity, including in Natura 2000 areas, areas facing natural or other specific constraints and high value farming, and the state of European landscapes
- Focus area 4B: Improving water management, including fertiliser and pesticide management
- Focus area 4C: Preventing soil erosion and improving soil management

PRIORITY 5: "Promoting resource efficiency and supporting the shift towards a low carbon and climate resilient economy in agriculture, food and forestry sectors"

- Focus area 5A: Increasing efficient in water use by agriculture
- Focus area 5B: Increasing efficiency in energy use in agriculture and food processing
- Focus area 5C: Facilitating the supply and use of renewable sources of energy, of by products, wastes, residues and other non-food raw material for purposes of the bio economy
- Focus area 5D: Reducing green gas and ammonia emissions from agriculture
- Focus area 5E: Fostering carbon conservation and sequestration in agriculture and forestry
