

Participants discussed the following main thematic issues:


- How to reduce the use of inputs as a way to increase the autonomy of farms?

EIP-AGRI upcoming seminar: 'New skills for digital farming'





SPAIN: 5-6 FEBRUARY 2020 DRAFT PROGRAMME

EIP-AGRI ANNUAL WORK PROGRAMME 2020: Process


