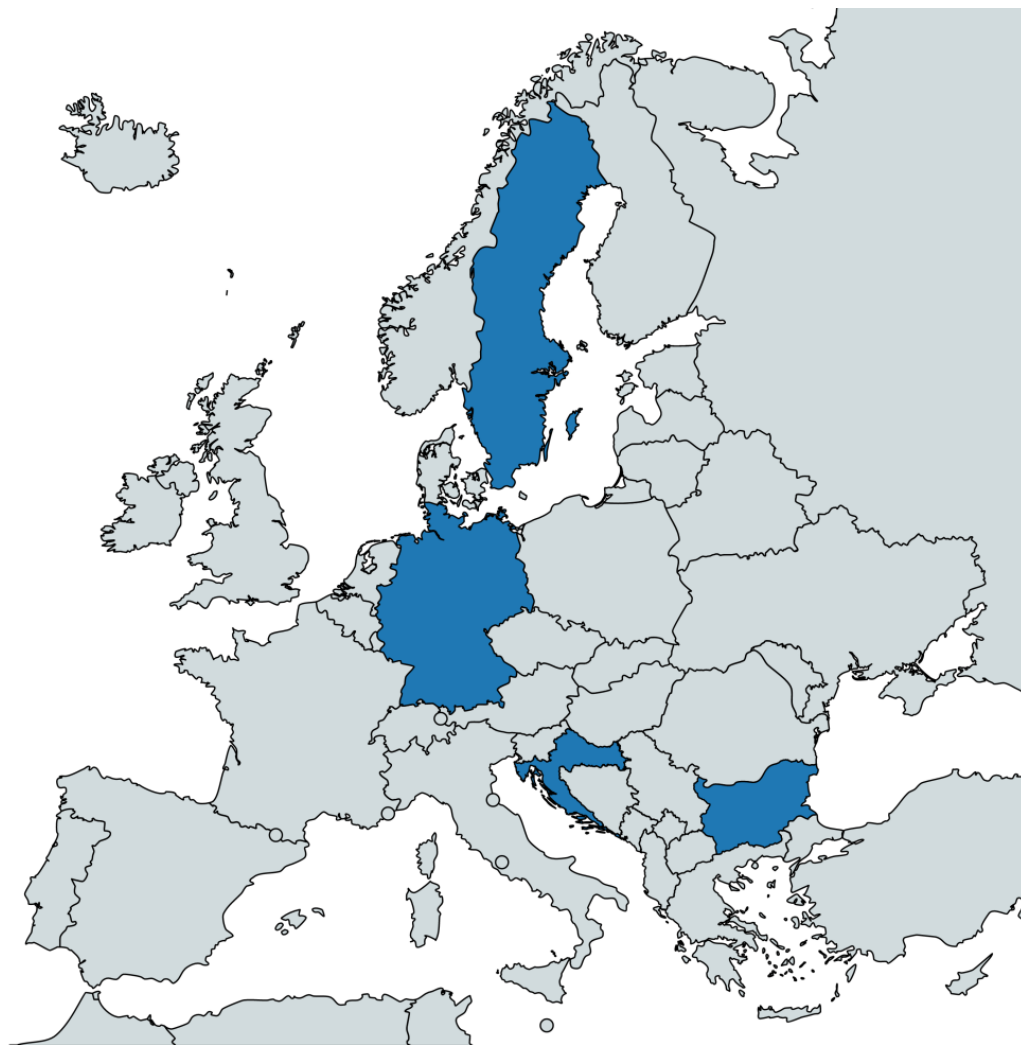

## Managing Authorities



- Managing Authorities as the main coordinating body
- The Managing Authority tends to be the overall supervisor of all bodies within the NRN structures, also developing and signing off the Annual Work Plans

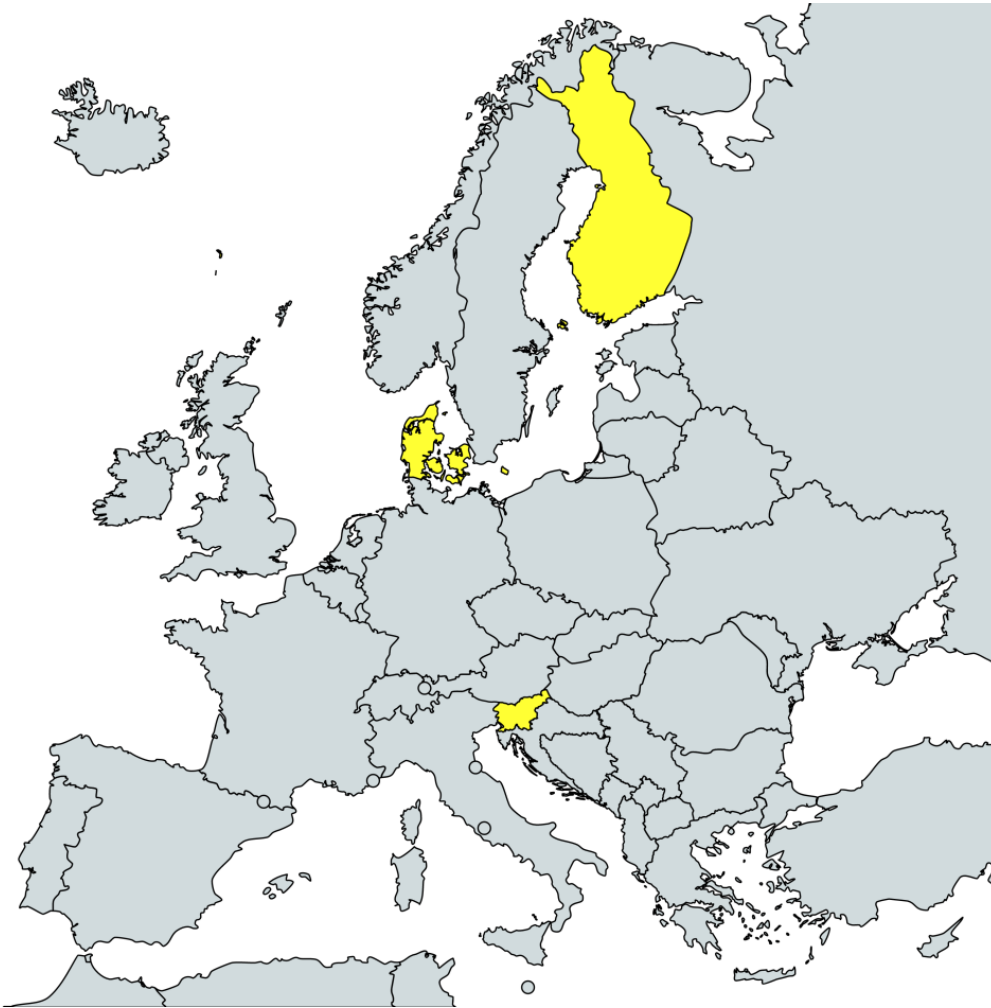
## Steering Committees

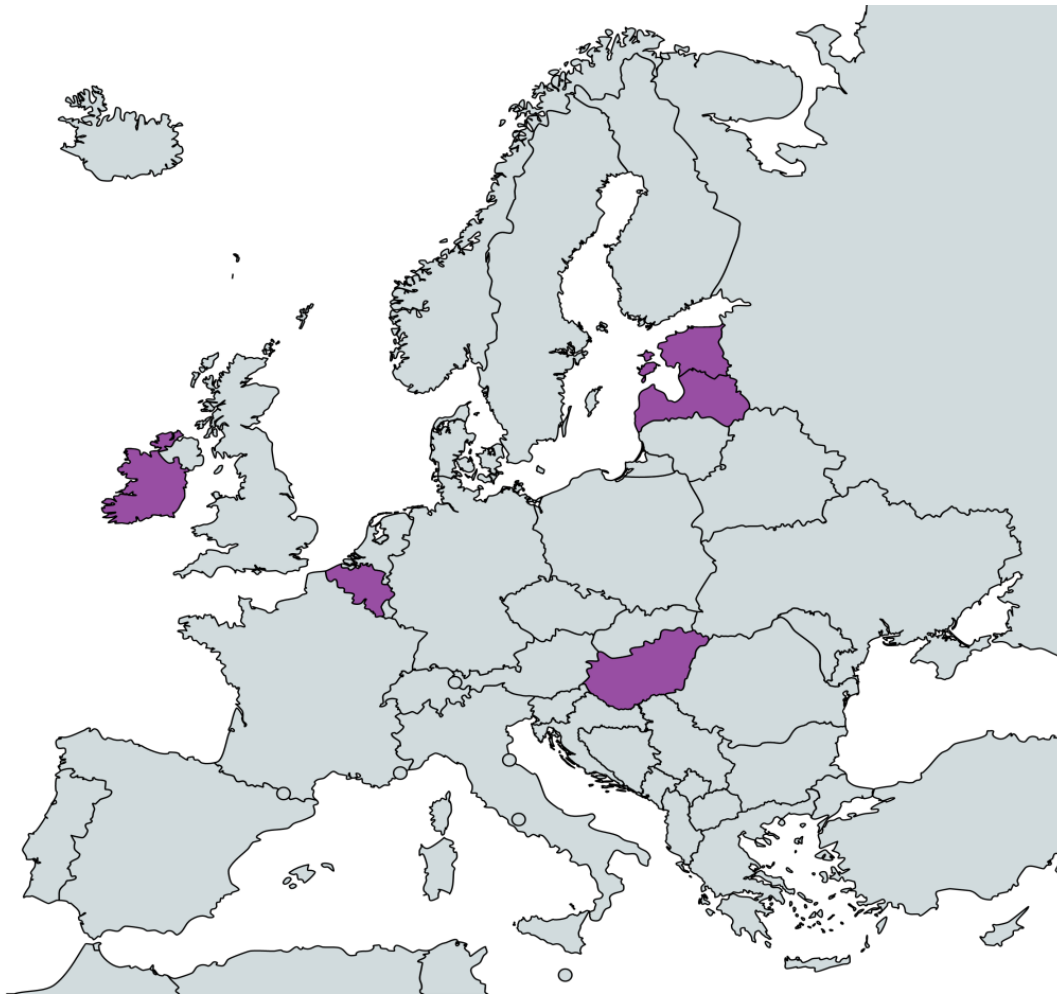


- Steering committees tend to consist of a limited number of stakeholders' representatives, e.g. nine permanent members in Croatia, 15 representatives in Bulgaria and Sweden

## Steering Groups

- The role is to coordinate stakeholders and members and enforce the communication, activities and objectives of the NRN
- Denmark (MA based), Finland and Slovenia





- In BE-VL the NSU organises a stakeholder meeting on a specific topic.
- In Ireland a 'coordination body'
- In Estonia 'cooperation chambers' and working groups
