




- MS with an Assembly: BE-W, ES, FR, GR (NRN Plenary)

- Ad-hoc working groups AT, LT, RO






#### **Managing Authorities**

- The Managing Authority tends to be the overall supervisor of all bodies within the NRN structures, also developing and signing off the Annual Work Plans




## **Steering Committees**

 Steering committees tend to consist of a limited number of stakeholders' representatives, e.g. nine permanent members in Croatia, 15 representatives in Bulgaria and Sweden






## **Steering Groups**
