

- > Support stakeholders in coherent dialogue, including foresight, to feed in to LTVRA.
- Coordinated communication to strengthen engagement.
- Contribute to ENRD LTVRA conference to involve and inform participant stakeholders and reflect process.

- ➤ Increase rural areas visibility, role and contribution in achieving EGD environmental and climate objectives, include current RDP lessons, contribute to CAP Strategic Plans.
- > Explore how European Green Deal strategy implementation can best support balanced, sustainable development (consider rural resilience).
