#### Origins and purposes



- French national federation of organic farmers
- Since 1978
- 10,000 farmers



- Since 2008
- 30 members : municipalities, natural parcs and water providers
- Objective : bottom-up organic farming development
- Funding : Ministry of Environment



## Supporting organic farming in the Avesnois

Key insights from a 10 years experiment

#### **Key elements to put in place:**

- ➤ Ensure a strong political backing, thanks to the involvement of elected representatives of the territory
- Create a dedicated governance, with all the technical and institutional actors concerned and maintain the territorial talk
- Regularly evaluate the process to adapt to the challenges and needs of the territory
- > Engage the territory in regional and national networks to share experiences and levers, make the territory visible and give legitimacy to the local actions
