1- A response to network members' expectations

A. Energize colleges and enhance them

Ce partenariat prend la forme en assemblée générale d'une organisation en 7 collèges :

- Meeting of all the member actors around a theme;
- Mobilization of colleges and actors who had little presence in representative bodies in the present;
- The increasing participation of rural intercommunal structures, elected officials, academics who discovered the news of the network via webinars.

2- Organisation of webinaires

Average webinar time: 2h00 (10h-12h00)

Plénière: 1h15 Workshop: 45min

Plenary interventions.

4 to 5 specialists and field actors to present different approaches for the same theme.

Participation: the possibility of intervening via a chat.

Interactions in conference mode. All participants are divided into subgroups. These exchanges in workshops allow to collect testimonies, new problems encountered in relation to the subject but also to initiate new actions to respond with the support of the national network.













3- Fallout / First observations

- More than 140 participants per session, more than 16 Regions represented for each webinar;
- Actors who are once again involved in the network's activities;
- A new audience: local elected officials, municipal technicians, academics...;
- An updated source page on each topic;
- Rich and participatory workshop uplifts;
- Facilitate the inter-knowledge of the actors through the presentations and facilitate in the workshop the rapprochement of the actors.
