In response to stakeholders' interest, the ENRD Contact Point is organising an online workshop to discuss the recently adopted [Regulation on transitional provisions](#) extending the legal framework of the current CAP to the years 2021 and 2022 and allowing for continuity of the policy, until the entry into force of the new CAP Strategic Plans. The event will also provide an opportunity to exchange views and share ideas and approaches on how to best use the additional resources made available for rural development by the [European Union Recovery Instrument \(EURI\)](#).

### Aims

The workshop aims to:

- Present key aspects and discuss the implications and main concerns of the Member States as regards the transitional provisions (laid down in [Regulation 2020/2220](#)) related to the implementation of the EAFRD for the years 2021 and 2022;
- Present the indicative areas to deploy EURI funding in line with EU priorities linked to recovery and resilience and discuss approaches on integration of the EURI funds into the Rural Development Programmes, contributing to the objectives of the EU Green Deal and, the Digital Agenda, and ensuring synergies with the Recovery and Resilience Facility Plans;
- Facilitate exchanges between Member States' representatives, collect and share opinion and ideas as well as identify any further support needs.
