Enhance participation

What was worked?

- ➤ Increased/more active involvement of stakeholders in meetings
- > Improved structure of meeting adapted to stakeholders needs

What can be further improved?

- Create a more flexible framework to promote more interaction between stakeholders
- ➤ More specific objectives focused on implementation of RD policies
- Promote more strategic debates in smaller groups and short presentations
- More contribution to agendas of the meetings by stakeholders
