








## The Objectives of Rural Network:

In 2013 the Rural Network is


a firm and flexible network of rural developers that brings benefits to the countryside.

a nationally and internationally recognised and valued partner and active pioneer in rural development.



Working Groups on different themes function as background animators and discussion forums for new ideas








#### Rural Network Unit

- started its activity in October 2007.
- operates as a unit of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry.
- is located in Seinäjoki, 350 kilometres north of Helsinki.
- has seven employees
- The Rural Network Unit coordinates the activity of the Rural Network and implements the tasks established for the network
- Rural Network operates in the years 2007-2013 and the total budget is the 12 million euros






#### Rural Network Unit

  - » promotion of internationalisation






#### Communication

  - training material available on the web pages
- Press releases on current issues
- Media campaigns on the opportunities offered by the Rural Development Programmes
- Participation in different kind of fairs
- Producing printed material and various kinds of PR material
- Guides on background info and supplementary material e.g. for project applicants, LAG-board members






## Good practices

- Best Practices 2010 -competition






## Training

  - > producing various kinds of training material






## Promoting internationalisation

- Hoasting study trips in Finland






## Yearly statistics
