The **"National Observatory for Female Enterprise and Labour in Agriculture" (ONILFA)** was founded in 1997 by the Italian *"Ministry of agriculture, food and forestry policies"* (MiPAAF) as an Institutional instrument aimed to verify actual employment possibilities for women in the rural sector, and formulate the necessary strategies.

ONILFA is also partner of international projects dealing with rural development:

- *GEWAMED Project:* (Mainstreaming Gender Dimension into Water resources Development and management in the Mediterranean Region) Main purpose of the project is to contribute to the mainstreaming of gender in the Integrated Water Resources Management (IWRM) in the Mediterranean Region, thus making water management more efficient and equitable. (financed by EU).
- TERCOM Project: Activation of mechanism to support rural territories and communities in Lebanon after the 2006 war in these territories. Within this project it has been created in 2008 an Observatory in Lebanon similar to the ONILFA called NOWARA, as a tool to sustain good agricultural practices through women activities. (financed by the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs).
- In 2010 the Italian Observatory has launched a project involving rural women in Haiti to transfer know how and best practices in the multifunctional sector with special reference to rural kindergartens.
