RD Programmes:

- Define the strategy to achieve policy objectives
- Set out the instruments and distribution of financial allocations to implement the strategy
- Provide the elements needed to compile the Partnership Contracts
- Provide the elements necessary to assess programmes' compliance with legal provisions



Content of programmes: main elements

- Ex-ante evaluation
- SWOT analysis
- Elements of the strategy: choice of measures per priority/focus areas, financial allocations to measures, approach towards innovation environment and climate change issues, etc.;
- Implementing arrangements: designation of relevant Authorities, consultation of partners, approach to local development strategies, monitoring & evaluation, etc.
- Financing plan;
- Indicator plan (target-setting!);
- *Performance framework and approach to ex-ante conditionalities*



From "axes" to "priorities"

- The six Union priorities for rural development:
 - Define the points of emphasis of the policy with respect to the needs for intervention identified at the level of the Union;
 - Are broken down into operational « focus areas » to better structure attribution of measures and planned interventions
- High degree of flexibility in the attribution of rural development measures to focus areas




Thematic sub-programmes (optional):

- To put emphasis on and address specific needs of particular sectors, geographical areas or types of beneficiaries (e.g young farmers, small farmers, mountain areas, short supply chain);
- Specific SWOT analysis, RD measures, targets and indicator plan
- No separate specific financial management



Programming in a nut-shell




Preparation aspects (incl. assessment of exante conditionalities)
