ENHANCING NRNs CAPACITY BUILDING

- Dynamic and bilateral exchanges between the Contact Point and the NRNs.
- Supporting integration of all rural stakeholders throughout a broad targeting of the rural community.
- Improving the use of EN RD/CP web-based tools in order to support the whole range of networking activities





SHARING INFORMATION AND KNOWLEDGE WITH ALL NRNs

- Four general <u>NRN meetings</u> in order to offer the opportunity for direct exchange of information and experiences.
- Structure of the meetings:
 - First part: CP/NRN exchanges on themes proposed by the CP after consultation with DG AGRI.
 - Second part: forum for exchanges amongst NRNs on topics of common interest.

Future meetings:

- 7th meeting: 10 December 2009 Brussels. Focus on thematic initiatives
- 8th meeting: February / March 2010 to be defined
- 9th meeting: May / June 2010 Brussels





ADDRESSING SPECIFIC NEEDS OF NRNs

- <u>Thematic networking</u>: supporting thematic cooperation between NRNs e.g.
- <u>Technical workshops</u> (organised after the general meetings) for groups of NRNs in order to provide guidance on specific topics. Suggestions:
 - 2nd TW: self-assessment for LAGs
 - 3rd TW: guidance on the evaluation of NRN activities
 - 4th TW: transnational cooperation
- Advisory missions: strengthening the capacity of the NRNs in preselected and agreed concerns.





TRANSNATIONAL COOPERATION

In the framework of the support activities undertaken by the CP, transnational cooperation will be considered as:

- A key area of EN RD / CP activity and support to NRNs
- A transversal topic to all common and specific themes of NRN interest
