#### Structure of Estonian Rural Network

- Estonian Rural Network Unit no formal membership,
  at the moment 4 full time employees + 3 part time
- Network Cooperation Chamber involves associations and organizations representing programme beneficiaries and organizations and authorities engaged in rural development. The members are selected according to the objectives of the axes of the Rural Development Plan
- Working groups:
  - Leader working group
  - Other working groups planned in near future
- Budget for period 2007-2013 max. 4.480.000 €



# Overall objective of Estonian Communication Strategy

To add value to the implementation of the Estonian Rural Development Programme, therefore:

- to increase exchange of experiences and knowlidge between rural actors;
- to exchange of experiences between LAGs;
- to increase collection, aggregation and dissemination of best practice and innovative approaches.



#### Target group of network communication activities

- Mainly 3 bigger target groups:
  - 1) 26 Local Action Groups (Axis 4)
  - 2) wider rural development (Axis 1-3)
  - authorities realted with implementing RDP (Axis 1-4)
- Keywords:
  - Step by step widening the target group (axis 1-3)
  - consideration of bottom-up initiative and cooperation

- 2007-2008 Support provided by the Rural Network to Leader action groups in transition to the new programming period
- 2009 i) international relations;
  ii) cooperation and common marketing
- 2010 best practises




