



Target in RDPs (Feb 2017): 2536





### Simplified EAFRD control rules

- Amended Regulation 809/2014 applicable as of 1/01/2018
- Extended deadline for checking reasonableness of costs
  (RoC) => if support rate up to 30% [art. 48(2)(e)]
  => for umbrella projects [art. 60(4)]
- If eligible costs of operations ≤ 5000 EUR
  - =>RoC may be established by a draft budget agreed ex-ante by managing authority [art. 48(2)(e)]
- No double checks between on-the-spot and administrative checks [art. 51(1)]



# Simplified rules in RDR and CPR (Omnibus)

- RDR amendments apply as of 1/01/2018
- CPR related changes expected in mid-2018
- No need for RDP to include statement confirming the adequacy and accuracy of the calculation of a standard cost [art. 62(2) RDR]=>possibility to have SCOs established outside the RDP
- New method for establishing SCO => draft budget established on a case by case basis and agreed ex ante by (...) the authority responsible for the selection of operations=> LAGs [art. 67(5)(a)(bis) CPR]



## Simplified rules in the CPR (2)

- New flat rates for indirect costs and personal costs [art.68 CPR]
- Possibility for each ESIF to support Technical Assistance operations eligible under any of the other Funds [art. 59 CPR]
- Lead Fund possible also for preparatory support [art. 32(4) CPR]
- Clarification of the capacity building role of LAGs
