#### **Provisions in LDS**

Supervision, monitoring and evaluation of internal LAG structures:

- Topics:
  - Boards and processes: Is work in resp. between the boards satisfying for the LAG's tasks? Are the processes coordinated and effective?
  - Animation visibility (public, potential beneficiaries), participation of different groups, ...
  - Cooperation participation in networks (national, EU-level), projects, ...
  - Performance LAG-Management (resources, training, ...)
  - Finances

#### **Provisions in LDS**

Supervision, monitoring and evaluation of LDS and project implementation (including reporting to MA)

- Mandatory use of impact oriented monitoring system:
  - Tool for self assessment and steerage of strategy implementation (matrix)

#### Communication of self assessment to MA

- Yearly report of LDS implementation LAG -> MA (end of February):
  - Data to projects: No. selected projects, rejected projects, withdrawn projects,...
  - Finances
  - Development of strategy implementation based on output oriented system (matrix) with link to projects
  - Description of working processes in the LAG, .. and whatever they want to tell to the MA
- Summary (MA) a d discussion with provinces, Paying Agency and LEADER-Forum
