
1. Knowledge Exchange : Networking events

1. Knowledge Exchange: Networking events


- Workshop “Farm data for better farm performance”

 - Aims at :

 - Providing an environment to exchange best practices on farm data collection, use and sharing.

- Workshop on organic farming

2. Knowledge Building: Focus Groups (FG)


Group of 20 experts with the relevant technical knowledge and geographical coverage:

 - 2 Meetings between February and June 2022




