Corona virus: emergency response

- CAP flexibility:
 - Fewer on-the-spot checks for investment operations
 - Possibility to replace in situ visits for investment projects with alternative evidence
 - MS can review their decisions of transfer between 1st and 2nd pillar



Rural Development under CRII+

- No amendment of Partnership Agreements in case of further programme amendments
- Expenditure of operations suspended or partly implemented due to Corona remains eligible (Force majeure)
- Rapid RDP reprogramming, to introduce measures linked to COVID, reinforce measures, reallocated envelopes to respond to Coronavirus crisis eligible as of 1 February 2020
- Amendments of RDPs in response to COVID do not count for the max number of modifications
- Accelerated procedure has been put in place for the Commission services to assess MS requests to modify their RDPs in response to the outbreak of the coronavirus (5 working days).



MFF and Recovery plan

- In May Commission revised proposal for Multiannual Financial Framework
- And proposed a recovery package
- July Council:
 - 386,6 bln EUR* for CAP (incl. 95,5 bln for EAFRD)
 - EAFRD allocation includes 8,07 bln EUR* under Next Generation EU
 - All EU expenditure to be consistent with Paris Agreement
- Discussion ongoing with the European Parliament too, following some proposals from the DE Presidency

State of play CAP reform proposals

Council

- RD main issues:
- environmental/climate ring-fencing
- indicator system and new delivery model (in particular performance review)
- DE Presidency aims for general approach in October

European Parliament

Amendments expected in plenary in Oct/2020



State of play Transitional Regulation proposal

- Commission proposed to extend implementation of RDPs by 1 year, to be funded from new MFF + measures to facilitate transition
- DE Presidency: 2-year transition, include Next Generation allocation in RDPs
- · Last trilogue expected in 2020, adoption subject to MFF



LEADER under Transitional Regulation

- LEADER can be supported until the end of the implementation period of the RDPs (if 2-year transition: max. until 2025)
- 5% ring-fencing applies to the whole extended RDP budget (but not funds transferred from DP)
- The possibility to support preparation and implementation of multi-funded CLLD according to the rules of new CPR: technical issue to be addressed



LEADER under Transitional Regulation

- To sum up: current strategies continue + possibility to prepare (and select) new multi-funded strategies
- Council proposal: possibility to prepare also mono-funded strategies
- If delay in adoption of CPR: technical solution to be found to support preparation and implementation of new strategies
