Performance Framework

Basis for reporting, monitoring and evaluation of the performance of the CAP Strategic Plan and of the whole CAP

Elements:

- ✓ The set of common indicators
- ✓ Quantified targets and annual milestones in the CAP Plans (result indicators)
- ✓ Data management and regular reporting activities on performance
- ✓ Incentive mechanisms to reward good performance and mechanisms addressing low under-performance (established in the Basic Act)
- ✓ Ex-ante, interim, ex-post and other evaluation activities





Objectives of the PME F

MONITORING

Monitor progress towards achieving objectives (against set milestones and targets for the specific objectives)

EVALUATION

Assess impact, effectiveness, efficiency, relevance, coherence and Union added value of the CAP

Support common learning process related to monitoring and evaluation.
