



Strategic Plans

Capacity building for MS administrations and other actors involved in CAP strategic Plan implementation

Collection, analysis, dissemination (actions supported)

Collection of information (statistics and administrative), analysis of developments in agriculture and rural areas

Platforms, fora and events for exchanges between stakeholders, incl. peer-to-peer learning, where relevant with 3rd countries

Collection of information and facilitation of networking (LAGs, EIP OGs)

Support to cooperation between LAGs and similar local development structures

Links to other EU funded strategies or networks



key principles governing the operation of the network (up to 2x, optional)









Network components (3 x 4)

green = online tools


blue = printed media

An incomplete draft layout ...







