The NSU is **established within the Managing Authority**, with some activities outsourced.

The NSU and the Monitoring Committee

Although the NRN is not a member of the RDP Monitoring Committee (MC), the head of the RDP Managing Authority is the **president** of both the RDP Monitoring Committee and the NRN Steering Committee.



NRN Governance

The Croatian National Rural Network has a **Steering Committee** that acts as a governance body:

It is composed of **9 permanent members** (and appointed substitutes).

The **president** is the Head of the Rural Development Programme (Managing Authority).

The first meeting of the NRN Steering Committee took place on 27 April 2016.
