

The NSU and RDP management

The NSU and the Managing Authority

The NRN of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg forms an integral part of the Ministry of Agriculture, Viticulture and Consumer Protection, which is the Managing Authority (MA).

✓ The NSU and the Monitoring Committee

- ✓ The Monitoring Committee of the RDP 2014-2020, which is composed of representatives of organisations and administrations working in the field of rural development and involved in rural development processes at both national and regional level, also has the role of the Coordinating Committee of the national rural network.
- ✓ Meeting once or twice a year, it comprises 27 members appointed by the ministry.
- ✓ There is no standing committee or general meeting of the network, but the committee may be open to new members during the programming period.
- ✓ This structure allows for regular exchange of information between all relevant actors.

Communication


The communication on the RDP must target two main stakeholders groups:
