- √ ~150 members representing 25 EU Member States + 3 third countries (FYROM, MD, NO) (including NRSs and RDPs' Managing Authorities and Paying Agencies, European organisations, farmers' associations, researchers and private sector representatives)
- √ From July 2018 to June 2019

- ✓ Regained momentum → Revision of the *EU Bioeconomy*Strategy (2017) and Future CAP proposals








