








EIP-AGRI ANNUAL WORK PROGRAMME 2019: Process







Main Priorities & Activities in 2019

Priorities	Activities
. Farm resilience: esource management and diversification.	Maintain work on the essential natural resources on which farming depends, giving special attention to climate change and biodiversity and intensifying the work on agricultural soil, in view of liaising with the European Joint Programme under Horizon 2020 and possible mission for Horizon Europe. • Focus Groups: • FG 34: Bee health and sustainable beekeeping. • FG 35: Diversification through niche products (medicinal and aromatic plants). • FG 36: Soil salinisation. • FG 37: Protecting agricultural soils from contamination. • FG 38: Antimicrobial resistance in poultry. • Workshop: • Explore crop diversification and crop rotation to improve the resilience of the farm; including enablers and barriers for arable crop diversification.


