


Types of members of the National Rural Network

► Regional Workshops: Addressing needs at regional level/Bottom-up approach; Thematic Working Groups

Training activities: LAG

Organization of international and national events: Operational Groups and other stakeholders

Promoting meetings with stakeholders in order to share practical experiences, good practices and knowledge: Thematic routes / demonstration visit,...









Ways of linking with new partners

- ▶ Regional Workshops/Thematic Working groups
- ► All the partners of the Operational Groups must be member of the NRN
- ► Organization of international and national events: with innovative projects (PT2020, H2020, INTERREG, LIFE, ...) and other stakeholders
- ► The search for relevant and innovative projects allows us to meet stakeholders in several sectors of activity (Edition of videos)

Concrete examples of a transferable practice

- ▶ 1. Regional Workshops:
 - This bottom-up approach allowded us to fit our work to the needs of the territories (thematic/needs to be worked by the network)
 - There were organized Thematic Working Groups with the support of experts.
- ▶ 2. Training activities: Evaluation of LEADER/CLLD at local level
 - Provide LAGs with the knowledge:
 - To monitor and assess the progress of the external evaluation
 - ► To conduct self-assessment and implement a robust monitoring and evaluation system at local level and at RDP level
- ▶ 3. Thematic routes / demonstration visit
 - ► Ex: organic farming, forest management, precision agriculture
